Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has been authorized as a repository of last resort for closed school academic records. The first records have been loaded and we are in the very early days of allowing requests for information or using the system to document contact information for institutions which have records stored in other locations. It will be a multi-year process in gathering academic records. We are also developing policy to require a standard format for academic records going forward to facilitate transfer to our agency if a school closes.

1. In June, SCHEV's Private Postsecondary Education division created guidance for entities requesting an exemption from certification. The guidance document clarifies definitions and requirements for requesting an exemption under 9 different categories granted by the Code of Virginia and the Virginia Administrative Code.

2. New legislation will be proposed by SCHEV's Private Postsecondary Education during the 2019 General Assembly session. Proposed wording is as follows:

All out-of-state institutions of higher education offering postsecondary Distance Learning to residents of the Commonwealth shall be fully accredited by an accrediting agency that is recognized by and has met the criteria for Title IV eligibility of the U.S. Department of Education.

Virginia has never regulated distance education unless the school has physical presence in Virginia. Last year we proposed legislation to require all institutions offering distance learning to residents of Virginia to be participants in a reciprocity agreement (i.e SARA). That legislation did not pass due to heavy lobbying by Walden U. This legislation, if passed will at least prevent unaccredited institutions from targeting Virginia residents.

3. SCHEV's Private Postsecondary Education division completed a major overhaul of its new school orientation (training) and the application process for new schools. We are seeking to create a better process to cull out schools that will be unable to meet the minimal requirements for certification earlier in the application process.

4. SCHEV's Private Postsecondary Education has contracted with a company called Virginia Interactive to create a database and website that will replace our current system for submitting applications, recertifications, complaints, requests for transcripts and all the other things we are responsible for. The new system will have an "online payment" feature. We hope to have the first phase completed by February 2019.

- Washington's 2018 legislative session saw the passage of HB 1439, which adds increased consumer protections; establishes a student tuition recovery trust fund intended for students who are adversely affected by school closures; and establishes a single complaint portal for complaints from any student attending an institution authorized or licensed by a state agency.

The Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) is currently engaged in a rule-making process to implement the new legislation.

- WSAC also recently added a staff member who will increase support for program reviews, site visits, and the development of resources for institutions and the public. The increased staff is based on revenue that will be generated through a fee change.
