

## Call for Conference Presentation Proposals Submission deadline: EXTENDED to November 30, 2021

The National Association of State Administrators and Supervisors of Private Schools (NASASPS) invites you to submit a proposal to present at its 2022 Annual Conference, which will be held April 24-27, 2022 in New Orleans, Louisiana.

The conference will include both submitted and invited presentations. Conference participants include professionals from state and federal regulatory agencies, degree and non-degree granting private postsecondary institutions, national and regional accrediting agencies, state guarantee agencies, lenders, and other interested parties.

Presentations are generally 60 minutes in length. They may be led by a single presenter or a moderated panel. While all presentation topics are encouraged and accepted, NASASPS has received requests for more information on the following:

- Best Practices and Not Re-inventing the Wheel
