The Utah legislature passed the Utah Postsecondary School and State Authorization Act in March of 2023. The effective date is January 1, 2024. Accreditation is no longer an exemption from the Act. This will impact those institutions that operate online in Utah who established an exemption with the Division based on their accreditation status. Registration will now be required. There were some changes to the exemption section and other areas regarding disclosures and outcomes. We are currently working on the financial viability structure for schools and will include this in the Administrative Rules later this year.

The Coordinating Board approved our request to increase SARA fees; the increase will become effective October 1, 2023. Additionally, the Board approved our request to revise fees collected for proprietary school administration. That request has to go through a rulemaking process, so will likely not become effective until July 2024 at the earliest. Funds received from these changes will be used to fund a new staff member who will split SARA and proprietary duties.

We also continue to have growing pains regarding regulation of training providers who participate in registered apprenticeships. It remains our contention that if a provider enrolls non-apprentices then that provider needs to be regulated. Otherwise those students will have no regulatory protections.

Florida's 2023 Legislature made several changes to the state laws governing private postsecondary educational institutions. Those changes include: updating licensure standards to require verification of high school attestations and to require all licensed institutions to submit retention and completion management plans with their initial and annual renewal applications; requiring disclosure of all programs offered, including those exempt by statute (e.g., avocational and continuing education programs); requiring institutional accreditation for prelicensure professional nursing programs prior to obtaining licensure approval; enhancing annual data collection requirements to include institutional graduation rates, including the number of graduates by program, and revising the definitions of retention and placement rates; and giving the commission authority to limit or prohibit student enrollment based on an institution's performance on licensure standards, placement of the institution on probation, or other adverse action taken by specified entities. The commission is currently in the process of promulgating rules to implement the new legislation.

Teaching sites update: The agency has been reviewing its long-standing policy on allowing teaching sites (a site where an authorized campus conducts only teaching and no other student services). However, due to a rise in some institutions taking advantage of this policy, the agency, along with general counsel, found that there is no statutory authority to allow this. A new policy will be proposed for later in the Fall that will require most teaching sites to be converted to authorized campuses. One wrinkle to this—mobile labs/teaching sites. The agency is trying to find the best way to move forward with this idea to all institutions to use a mobile site to better serve underserved areas.

Unaccredited degrees policy change: In 2020, the agency began the process of ending unaccredited degrees in the state. The timeline for ending all unaccredited graduate degrees was July 1, 2023. However, the agency extended the timeline due to COVID. Institutions have raised concerns on the ability of new, degree-granting institutions being able to start in the state due to this policy. The agency's position is that there is a narrow path for this to occur under our policy.

Digital surrender of records: Our agency is researching how other states are handling student record surrenders. We would like to require institutions to submit only digital records. Should we require institutions to digitize all records and review at annual site visits? What would the requirements be for past records? Will old records be grandfathered in or would digitization be required? What resources do we need to develop to make sure institutions are successful and comply? Would there be penalties for hard copy records submitted to us? Would it be worth trying to collect penalties?

Proposed Legislation on Performance Metrics

Proposed legislation, SB 3536, would require the agency to establish performance metrics that include measures student learning, retention, graduation, and post-graduation outcomes. Institutions would also be required to identify peer and aspirational peer institutions against which to compare and display its metrics. If enacted, the law would take effect immediately and will apply to the first full academic year following the date of enactment. The bill was introduced and referred to the Senate Higher Education Committee on January 30, 2023.

Proposed Legislation on Reporting Requirements for OPM Contracts

Proposed legislation, SB1112, would require degree-granting institutions that enter into contracts with an online program manager (“OPM”) to submit an annual expenditure report to the Secretary of Higher Education, which will include data on total payments to the OPM, students using state aid for OPM programs, and the OPM’s expenses on services to the institution. The reports, which will be published online, are due within 60 days of any of the following: a new contract, a substantive change to a contract, a renewal of a contract, and, for contracts already in effect, the effective date of the law. The bill is currently under review by the Senate Higher Education Committee. If enacted, the legislation would take effect immediately. Text of the bill is available here: <https://www.njleg.state.nj.us/bill-search/2022/S1112>.

Proposed legislation, SB 1113 and SB 1114, would also place additional requirements on degree-granting institutions that enter into contracts with OPMs. Specifically, SB 1113 would require degree-granting institutions that retain an OPM for marketing services require the OPM to identify itself as a third party in the beginning of communications with prospective students and disclose the relationship with the OPM and school on any digital or print advertising. SB 1114 would require degree-granting institutions that enter into contracts with OPMs to publicly disclose information about the relationship. Both bills are currently under review by the Senate Higher Education Committee. If enacted, SB 1113 would take effect 30 days after enactment and SB 1114 would take effect immediately.

Final Legislation P.L.2023, c.115 Supporting Financial Stability and Operational Accountability of Public Institutions of Higher Education

Legislation requires public institutions of higher education to submit annual fiscal monitoring reports and undergo a comprehensive audit in addition to submitting annual audits, and authorizes the Secretary of Higher Education to appoint a State monitor who shall provide direct oversight of a public institution of higher education’s fiscal and governance operations if the fiscal monitoring report or comprehensive audit of the institution includes a finding of financial instability, the institution receives an adverse or disclaimer opinion in its annual audit, or if any two of following criteria are met: The institution ends the fiscal year with a deficit balance in certain funds; the institution fails to develop and implement a plan to address a deficit balance in certain funds; the institution receives a qualified opinion in its annual audit or fiscal monitoring report; the institution receives an adverse, disclaimer, or qualified opinion under a single audit section in its annual audit or the fiscal monitoring report; the institution receives any audit findings identified as material weaknesses in internal controls in the annual audit; the institution fails to implement a plan from the prior fiscal year which causes any findings from the independent auditor to be repeated; the institution fails to submit the annual audit or the fiscal monitoring report; or the institution fails to comply with the timely training of governing board members. The legislation also requires higher education chief financial officers complete training.

Proposed legislation AB 4971 would require four year public institutions of higher education to post on its website the average time-to-degree completion for each baccalaureate degree awarded by the institution; and also would require county colleges to post on its website an appropriate measure of student outcomes as determined by the Secretary of Higher Education, in consultation with the New Jersey Council of County Colleges, for each associate degree awarded by the institution. In addition, the legislation also requires

public institutions of higher education to post on its website a copy of the institution's annual fiscal monitoring report. The bill was referred to the Assembly Appropriations Committee on May 18, 2023. If enacted, AB 4971 would take effect immediately and shall first apply to the first full academic year following enactment.

Proposed legislation AB 4967, would revise training requirements for governing board members of public institutions of higher education and as a condition of serving as a member of the governing board of a public institution of higher education, a person would be required to complete a training program developed by the Secretary of Higher Education that is designed to clarify the rules and duties of a governing board member. The bill was referred to the Assembly Appropriations Committee on May 18, 2023. If enacted, AB 4967 would take effect on the 1st day of the seventh month next following the date of enactment.

Final Legislation on Quality Metrics for Degree-Granting and Nondegree-Granting Schools

N.J.Stat.§18A:3B-45.1 requires the Secretary of Higher Education and the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to establish certain quality metrics for all institutions based on the ratio of tuition and fees to average earnings of New Jersey workers employed in the occupation for which the program prepares students. Schools that fail to meet the minimum standard will have their program terminated and/or the school license revoked. The bill also requires private career schools to submit quarterly reports on tuition and fees and student records. Both of the agencies will be obligated to establish the performance standard within 12 months of the date the bill was enacted. The legislation took effect on July 29, 2022.

On June 28, 2023, the Office of the Secretary for Higher Education (OSHE) held its first 'Some College, No Degree' statewide convening. This convening gathered over 200 higher education practitioners, researchers, and administrators to Middlesex College to share best practices to better serve the 750,000 New Jersey residents who have earned some college credit, but left school before earning a degree. The goals of the convening include sharing preliminary data and lessons learned from year one of the statewide initiative—with a focus on the State Partnership with ReUp Education—as well as strategizing best practices and next steps to better serve this population moving forward. The convening agenda may include discussions on national and state data highlights on the SCND population, exploring student-centered practices to better serve this population, remarks from returning students, breakout sessions on focused subject matter areas, and action-planning for implementing best practices.

The New Jersey Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) continues to partner with Uwill and participating New Jersey public institutions and public-mission independent institutions to deliver a wide range of tele-mental health services for students

The State of New Jersey launched [Transgender.NJ.gov](https://www.info.nj.gov/transgender) New Jersey's Transgender Information Hub. Announced on International Transgender Day of Visibility by Governor Phil Murphy, this information hub exists to assist New Jersey's transgender and non-binary community in finding information on important programs and services. Some of the information available on this one-stop hub includes, but is not limited to: finding mental health resources, obtaining medical support, understanding legal protections, and acquiring legal assistance. This website will provide insight into the rights of transgender and non-binary students. This streamlined website is a result of engagement with the transgender and non-binary community. The site will be launched as a beta version, allowing for continual updates and enhancements based on feedback from stakeholders. Institutions are encouraged to share this resource with their campus communities.

The Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) and New Jersey's Department of Education (NJDOE) released the New Jersey Dual Enrollment Study Commission report.

The Commission was established through legislation signed by Governor Phil Murphy (P.L. 2018, c.145) and charged with studying "issues related to the implementation of an expanded dual enrollment program" and issuing a framework expanding dual enrollment. NJDOE and OSHE are also releasing website resources, including a step-by-step toolkit, and providing technical assistance for high schools and colleges looking to expand their dual enrollment offerings.

A change is state statute, outside of our own statute that requires schools to provide students with transcripts, even if the student's financial responsibilities to the school has not been met. Students can obtain transcripts in this instance if it is for the purpose of seeking employment or applying to other institutions of higher education. We are proposing a clarification in our rule that requires students to provide proof to the schools that they need the transcripts for either of those purposes.

We are under sunset review and one of the recommendations being made is that our statute be changed to require notification of changes of ownership, and Board approval of the change take place prior to the actual closing date of the transfer of ownership.

A new funding source is available in CO for schools providing education in medical specialties fields. Initial funding went only to the public institutions of higher education, though the statute allows for allocations to occupational and technical schools. We are working this year on obtaining funding for some of the DPOS schools who are accredited. Our first step in this process is providing information and tours of schools to Department leadership, Governor's office and legislators to highlight the education being provided at these schools, and statistics on placements of students in th workforce.
