Pennsylvania Initiatives:

1. State Board of Higher Education (SBHE):

The newly established State Board of Higher Education (SBHE) was established by 2024 Public School Code, as a result of Governor Shapiro's blueprint for higher education and is tasked with re-envisioning higher education in the Commonwealth and increasing access and affordability for Pennsylvania's postsecondary students. Board materials can be found on the Pennsylvania State Board of Higher Education website.

Established under revisions made to the Public-School Code this year, SBHE will provide the capacity and the support that higher education leaders need to develop a statewide strategic plan for the sector and work together to achieve goals critical to the Commonwealth. To support these efforts, the Board will create a new postsecondary data system, provide guidance and capacity to institutions facing fiscal challenges, and create stronger and more affordable pathways to postsecondary credentials and degrees.

2. PA C.A.R.E.S Campus (Connect; Assess; Respond; Encourage; Support); Campaign Kickoff: May 2025:

The PA C.A.R.E.S. Campus (Connect; Assess; Respond; Encourage; Support) initiative will serve as the forward-facing campaign for Act 110 of 2018, that annually encourages the submission of mental health and suicide prevention plans by Pennsylvania's postsecondary institutions. The legislation provides specific criteria for submitted plans and recognizes the authority to designate them as Certified Suicide Prevention Institutions of Higher Education for their preventive work. Currently, there are fifth-teen designated institutions for 2024-2025, with the goal of the campaign to increase this number.

Falling within the broader, PA MASLOW: Hierarchy of Collegiate Basic Needs, framework's mental health pillar, the PA C.A.R.E.S. initiative will provide the following:

- Institutions that achieve this designation will:
- Receive a certificate of recognition from the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
- Receive public recognition through placement on the PA C.A.R.E.S Campus website (to be developed) with a statement indicating that the campus is committed to supporting the mental health and well-being of students and is part of the collective effort to raise awareness of resources to prevent suicide.
- Be able to use the PA C.A.R.E. logo on materials to indicate the institution's awareness of and supportive measures.
- Be prepared for related grant opportunities that may become available.

3. Establishing a Central Repository. Some activities in progress are developing an internal information and application management system and coordinating actions across state and federal agencies that share regulatory responsibilities.

Final Legislation N.J.S.A. 18A:3B-53.1 through 53.10; P.L.2023, c.115 Supporting Financial Stability and Operational Accountability of Public Institutions of Higher Education Legislation requires public institutions of higher education to submit annual fiscal monitoring reports and undergo a comprehensive audit in addition to submitting annual audits, and authorizes the Secretary of Higher Education to appoint a State monitor who shall provide direct oversight of a public institution of higher education's fiscal and governance operations if the fiscal monitoring report or comprehensive audit of the institution includes a finding of financial instability, the institution receives an adverse or disclaimer opinion in its annual audit, or if any two of following criteria are met: The institution ends the fiscal year with a deficit balance in certain funds; the institution fails to develop and implement a plan to address a deficit balance in certain funds; the institution receives a qualified opinion in its annual audit or fiscal monitoring report; the institution receives an adverse, disclaimer, or qualified opinion under a single audit section in its annual audit or the fiscal monitoring report; the institution receives any audit findings identified as material weaknesses in internal controls in the annual audit; the institution fails to implement a plan from the prior fiscal year which causes any findings from the independent auditor to be repeated; the institution fails to submit the annual audit or the fiscal monitoring report; or the institution fails to comply with the timely training of governing board members. The legislation also requires higher education chief financial officers complete training. Final Legislation on Quality Metrics for Degree-Granting and Nondegree-Granting Schools N.J.Stat.§18A:3B-45.1 requires the Secretary of Higher Education and the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to establish certain quality metrics for all institutions based on the ratio of tuition and fees to average earnings of New Jersey workers employed in the occupation for which the program prepares students. Schools that fail to meet the minimum standard will have their program terminated and/or the school license revoked. The bill also requires private career schools to submit quarterly reports on tuition and fees and student records. Both of the agencies will be obligated to establish the performance standard within 12 months of the date the bill was enacted. The legislation took effect on July 29, 2022. OSHE Awards \$1.6 Million in Second "Some College, No Degree" Grant Cycle, Partners with Ithaka S+R
The New Jersey Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) continues its commitment through the multifaceted statewide 'Some College, No Degree' initiative for a third year, strategically integrating partnerships and grants to build clear pathways and tailored supports for adult learners to return to higher education and persist to completion. As of November 2024, through the partnership between OSHE, ReUp Education (ReUp) and 22 institutions of higher education alone, outreach and personalized coaching has empowered over 8,600 residents to re-enroll and over 350 of them to graduate. Graduates with an Associate's degree could earn approximately \$3,700 per year in increased wages, while those with a Bachelor's could earn approximately \$25,000. It is estimated that in the first year after earning their degree or credential, these graduates could contribute an added \$81 million to the state economy through taxes and consumer spending.

Fiscal Year 2024 Financial Assessment and Risk Monitoring Cycle

The Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) is pleased to share that the FY2024 cycle of the Financial Assessment and Risk Monitoring (FARM) program has commenced for higher education institutions in the State of New Jersey. The financial assessment and risk monitoring is conducted as required by P.L. 2021, c. 27 and P.L. 2023, c. 115. We remain committed to fostering fiscal transparency and supporting the resilience of higher education institutions. Through this process, OSHE will determine the financial stability of higher education institutions as an accountability measure for the benefit of students, their families, and the taxpayers of New Jersey.

New Jersey Career Accelerator Internship Grant Program One hundred thirty-three (133) New Jersey-based employers have received

grants through the Career Accelerator Internship Grant Program ("Career Accelerator") to provide 5/4 paid summer internships to New Jersey college students, including those who currently attend or graduated from an in-state college or university in the last 12 months or are New Jersey residents attending a college out-ofstate. The grants are supporting students and graduates with opportunities that pay \$20 per hour and require a commitment of 150-200 hours over a 10-week summer period. This summer marks the third year in which the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) has administered and coordinated Career Accelerator. . Supported by \$2.4 million from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development, OSHE has grown the number of internship opportunities for the summer 2024 cohort by 23 percent over last year. To ensure students gain valuable skills, participating employers must provide a structured learning experience by assigning interns a designated supervisor who provides feedback aligned to learning objectives and goals. Additionally, this year, Career Accelerator-sponsored interns are receiving six months of free access to LinkedIn Learning.
