



Who is GNPEC?

Mission:

The agency's mission is to ensure that each authorized nonpublic postsecondary educational institution in Georgia is satisfying its commitments to hardworking Georgians through sound academics and financial stability.

Priorities:

GNPEC ensures that all institutions meet minimum standards while providing outstanding customer service and efficiency. The goal is to effectively engage all relevant stakeholders in the process (students, faculty, and institutions).

Institutions:

As of March 2022, GNPEC authorizes 346 institutions. This includes schools that are accredited and unaccredited along with degree-granting and non-degree granting. As of March 2022, a majority are unaccredited.

Initial Authorization:

Authorization is required of any institution seeking to offer postsecondary education from within or outside Georgia to residents of this State. GNPEC accepts and approves initial applications on a rolling basis throughout the year.
