On July 28, 2022, the Commission adopted rules expected to be effective on or near December 28, 2022. No fee increases were included in the rules. However, it is anticipated that total revenues will increase as the path for Optional Expedited Authorization was opened to non-degree granting institutions.

We are also working to reorganize staff such that the attorney and paralegal that worked solely with the Division of Postsecondary State Authorization are moving to Bureau-wide roles. It is expected that the staffing changes will be an evolving change that will take approximately six (6) months to complete.

Currently, accreditation is not required in order for a private postsecondary educational institution to be licensed in Florida. The Commission is proposing for the 2023 Florida legislative session that all institutions offering pre-licensure professional nursing (RN and above) programs be institutionally accredited prior to receiving commission program approval. This proposal is aimed at addressing the need for high quality nursing education due to NCLEX pass rates in the state.

The Commission serves as the portal entity for Florida SARA. Approximately 100 degree granting institutions in Florida are participating in SARA.

The Florida Department of Education and the Commission for Independent Education are both under new leadership. Going forward, there will be a focus on institutional accountability and a greater use of data metrics to evaluate the performance of licensed institutions.
