Legislation regarding MCCA was passed in March 2023 specifying that (1) MCCA shall be housed at IHL; (2) IHL shall appoint staff to manage MCCA; (3) IHL shall charge MCCA for the actual cost incurred; (4) MCCA shall establish fees to cover the commission's direct and indirect costs to be paid to IHL; and (5) "domiciled" shall mean conducting postsecondary academic activity, including field placements, within the state of Mississippi.

MCCA Standards and Regulations for State Authorization of Academic Degree-Granting Postsecondary Institutions were last reviewed/revised in 2015. At its March 2023 meeting, MCCA approved revised Standards and Regulations as well as an increase in fees. The Standards and Regulations are currently available for public comment.

Now that state legislation has stated that "domiciled" includes field placement, MCCA is working to develop standards, policies, procedures, and fees associated with field placements. This is not part of the current revisions to MCCA Standards and Regulations.

Currently all applications regardless of whether the institution is existing and expanding to the state or a start up business, must submit a CPA reviewed or audited financial statement identifying certain financial areas. SB345 will eliminate the need for financial documents to be reviewed or audited for startup businesses and allow for CPE to develop a separate process for newly established institutions. This bill will also require CPE to review our Administrative Code every five years versus the 10 year review period.

SB 431 is a state restructure bill that would change CPE's division to Department of Workforce and require rebranding.

Kansas updated the financial requirements and added the authority to condition an intuitions certificate of approval based on financials or other concerns.

The updated financial requirement language is listed in K.A.R. 88-28-2(a)(6).

(6) The owner of the institution or the owner's designee shall submit to the state board the most recent financial statements for the institution operating in Kansas and for any parent or holding companies related to that institution. The financial statements provided to the state board shall demonstrate a profit earned before depreciation, amortization, and taxes and meet at least one of the following requirements for the most recent fiscal or calendar year:

(A) Demonstrate a minimum ratio of current assets to current liabilities of at least 1:1. This asset ratio shall be calculated by adding the cash and cash equivalents to the current accounts receivable and dividing the sum by the total current liabilities. Recently, the Utah State Legislature passed S.B. 180 repealing and replacing the Utah Postsecondary School State Authorization Act with the Utah Postsecondary School and State Authorization Act ("Act"), effective January 1, 2024. The bill can be reviewed on the Utah State Legislature's website at: <https://le.utah.gov/~2023/bills/static/SB0180.html>.

The Act requires accredited institutions to submit a registration statement with the Division of Consumer Protection ("Division") every two years, modifies the exemption, registration, and surety requirements, requires certain outcome disclosures and clarifies the Division's enforcement authority, in addition to other changes. An exemption based on accreditation will no longer be available.

Definition of "Operate":

maintain a physical presence in the state; or  
provide postsecondary education to an individual who resides in the state.

Definition of "Physical presence":

to maintain in the state a physical location where a student receives postsecondary education; or  
to provide to a student distance postsecondary education from a location in this state.

The Florida Commission for Independent Education recently has undergone leadership changes. With the addition of seven new commissioners and a new Executive Director, ways to promote institutional accountability, enhance data collection, ensure student success and consumer protection, and align educational opportunities with workforce needs are all being examined. The Florida Legislature is currently underway and considering legislation to require accreditation of all degree-granting institutions which is a significant change as Florida currently does not require institutions to be accredited in order to be licensed. In an effort to promote nursing program quality, the legislation also prohibits an institution from offering a nursing program until accreditation is obtained. Further, the commission's rules are undergoing comprehensive revision to incorporate new distance education policies and procedures and align more with the rules governing the public educational sector as workforce initiatives are developed that require collaboration among the various public and private sectors.

Of particular note for NASASPS members is that out-of-state for-profit institutions, which must register with the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education before enrolling Californians, must refrain from engaging in prohibited business practices outlined in California Education Code section 94897. Prohibited practices include withholding transcripts due to unpaid debts, requiring students or employees to sign non-disclosure agreements, and making false or misleading statements to students or prospective students. Nursing education:

SB0458 and HB4684 would not allow the Texas Board of Nursing to approve nursing educational programs by a for-profit entity unless it provides evidence of three specific criteria – program won't result in decrease in number of clinical positions for public institutions in the region; reporting of NCLEX passage rates in other states; and statement from clinical site that clinical positions for public institutions won't be decreased. The bill will also allow the Board of Nursing to withdraw approval of a program offered by a for-profit entity if the Board determines there is a decrease in number of clinical practice nursing positions available to students from public institutions of higher education because of the for-profit program. The bill would only allow the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to authorize an accredited nursing program at the same level as a SARA agreement, i.e., ten or less students at one site; or authorize an unaccredited institution if it can show capacity from other area programs are insufficient to meet current market needs, they have the faculty and resources for student success, and agrees to meet professional criteria followed by institutions of higher education. The Senate bill has had some movement is currently engrossed and passed out of the Senate.

Accreditation:

SB1913 and HB5192 would change the definition of "Private or independent institution of higher education" in THECB statute from those only accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) to include institutions accredited by any recognized accrediting agency. This would change the status for many private postsecondary institutions in Texas and allow them to receive certain grants and benefits. It would also subject them to additional reporting requirements. These bills have not progressed past the Introduced status.

The Texas 88th legislative session is Sine Die as of May 29, 2023. We do not know the final outcomes of these bills until they complete the house and senate approval process and are signed, vetoed or allowed to become law without a signature.
