Starting May 2020, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) is requiring institutions, prior to establishing a new degree program to evaluate the need for the proposed program of study through survey, research, or other means of measure. This includes an analysis of the capacity and ability of similar programs at public, private or independent institutions of higher education and private postsecondary educational institutions within Texas to meet market needs.

Prior to January 2020, for-profit institutions wanting to establish new physical presence in Texas were required to have a statement from the owner(s) of no involvement in a bankruptcy, felony, or governmental regulatory disciplinary action. THECB now requires this statement for institutions each year during annual compliance reporting.

THECB is in the process of reviewing all its rules regarding private postsecondary institutions for any necessary revisions to ensure we are in line with all statutory requirements. Texas will begin its every other year legislative session in January 2021. We are unsure if any statutory changes will be passed during the 2021 which will affect our rules or oversight.

- Virtual Site Visits from March to June 2020: Leveraged technology in place to continue regulation of schools remotely. Both initial and renewal applicants were visited.
 - Potential Permanent Remote Work: Proposals have been submitted to the Governor's Office for review concerning permanent remote work, reducing real estate footprint, etc. Having the infrastructure in place prior to COVID (Cyanna) was key to success.
 - Argosy Bond Conclusion: Following the closure of Argosy University, our agency was refused bond payouts for two \$200,000 bonds. However, after involvement of the state's Office of the Attorney General, the surety company paid out both bonds in full. A claim period was opened, students submitted claims and documentation, claims were evaluated, and valid claims were paid out. Over \$300,000 was reimbursed to students with valid claims.
