State-wide mask mandates expired March 11th; we are looking forward to updated COVID guidance going forward.

The Private School unit completed our contract with EDvera and will be launching our newly developed licensing system in May. This system will allow schools to upload their materials and track progress and will enable agency staff to be more efficient when processing renewal and initial licensing applications.

Washington state's nationally recognized online career and education platform CareerBridge.wa.gov was recently provided \$460,000 by the state's legislature to modernize the site, which launched more than 10 years ago. This funding includes hiring an IT project manager, upgrading the site's architecture to make it mobile-friendly, and hiring a user-experience consultant to create a more dynamic tool, especially for younger users. These investments also lay the groundwork for creating a digital portfolio to save career and education searches and better aligning Career Bridge with High School and Beyond Plans to help students chart their next education and career steps.

DPOS is in the process of migrating all data to the new IT system it anticipates launching in April of 2022

A law pass as a result of Western State Construction College (WSCC) desire to obtain state authorization through DPOS. WSCC is an institution that primarily offers 2 year apprenticeship programs and training in the construction industry. Because they offer apprenticeships, WSCC was exempt from DPOS oversight. However, in order to maintain authorization for VA funds, last legislative session, WSCC introduced a bill to provide an exception to the mandatory exemption of apprenticeship programs and training in construction and also passes a provision allowing CHEEA to serve as a substitute for ED approved accreditation. These amendments were passed last legislative session. Currently they are attempting to further introduce regulatory amendments that would do away with our rules requiring separate sites to apply as a school (as opposed to being admitted as multiple sites under one umbrella approval). We are interested in hearing whether other states HE Agency oversees or exempts apprenticeships (or whether another state agency does so). Similarly, we would like to know how many states permit CHEEA to serve as DE approved accreditation and whether other states register/apply as separate locations to approve each as an individual schools.

Legislation is pending in Tennessee that will change the traditional regulatory function in Tennessee. Of note are the following: terminate the Committee on Postsecondary Educational Institutions, remove the requirement for agents to be permitted, allows non-degree granting schools to be eligible for OEA ("fast track" authorization), Requires out-of-state exempt institutions with no Tennessee location to be authorized if they place students in supervised field experiences in Tennessee, deletes requirement that certain exempt institutions file a request with THEC every year to remain exempt, allows multi-year authorization with annual compliance certification, allows provisional authorization by Executive Director subject to THEC ratification, allows for a simplified process of "program registration" rather than "approval," and allows a successful tuition guarantee fund claim to be paid directly to the student. Nursing schools

In response to the nursing shortage in Florida, the state is experiencing an increase in the number of private nursing schools seeking licensure by the Commission. In order to ensure that these new institutions provide a quality education and properly prepare their students for successful nursing careers, the Commission is reviewing its standards, policies and procedures. A policy committee is being organized to identify best practices, including admissions standards, recordkeeping requirements for clinicals and placements and distance education requirements for general education and nursing core courses. With approximately 150 private nursing schools currently operating in Florida, identification of best practices will focus on those schools whose NCLEX pass rates are within ten percent of the national average, indicating a successful program.

Distance Education

Florida's administrative rule regulating delivery of distance education is outdated and in need of revision. Temporary approvals for online delivery during Covid-19 have long expired in our state and an increasing number of institutions are now seeking permanent approval of online delivery for a wide variety of programs, including cosmetology, massage therapy and nursing. Commission staff are reviewing other states' distance education rules and identifying language that would be helpful in our rule revision process. Staff are also reaching out to other state regulators to elicit ideas and suggestions on how to "cover all the bases" on this comprehensive issue.

Fee Increase – SB1065

The Arizona State Board for Private Postsecondary Education identified the need for fee increase as a result of increased operating costs and the complexity of the institutional application review process. The Board operates under a fee structure that was last updated in 1996. As a result, the Board conducted two stakeholder meetings representing 10% of currently licensed institutions with the intent to draft legislation that would secure the long-term viability of the Board while being very aware of the financial challenges schools face. The stakeholder group provided input, suggestions, and modifications, ultimately reaching a consensus on the language of SB1065. Additionally, all 232 currently licensed schools were asked for input regarding this legislation. The response was extremely supportive of SB1065.

Current Status: SB1065 passed the Senate with a 23 to 4 vote. The bill is currently in the House awaiting review from the Rules Committee.

If the fee increase is passed and signed by the Governor, fees would increase in July 2022.

Specifically, what does the rule require and what exception(s) are carved out based on an institution's participation in the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement? Here's the proposed language in its entirety, for reference:

(32) In each State in which the institution is located or in which students enrolled by the institution are located the institution is otherwise required to obtain State approval under 34 CFR 600.9, the institution must ensure that each program—

(iii) Complies with all State consumer protection laws, including both generally applicable State laws and those specific to educational institutions, except where State requirements for obtaining authorization are inapplicable pursuant to a State authorization reciprocity agreement.
