The New Mouse Trap

- ∴ Protect Integrity
- ∴ Upgrade Content/Relevancy
- ∴ Deal with Loss of Control Upon Separation/Completion

Application in the Last 25% of Program & Institutional Certification on Practical Skills

- ∴ Ability to Re-educate if Unsuccessful
- ∴ Encourage Re-takes
- ∴ Work-Ready at Graduation
- ∴ Enter Tax Paying Workforce Faster
- ∴ Reduce Agency Costs

The New Mouse Trap

Reduces Costs

- ∴ Eliminate the Cost of Test Sites
- ∴ Eliminate/Restrict Temporary Licensing
- ∴ Charge Commensurate Fees

Ensures Greater Transparency

- ∴ Require Random Audits
- ∴ Require Institutions to Post Certification Dates
